

CANADIAN INTERNATIONAL ONE LOFT RACE

In the last decade or so, one loft races have become more and more popular in our sport, all over the world. Many fanciers have pigeons of superior quality and find the one loft racing scene can offer fair competition and a true test of their quality.

After ten years of enjoyable and successful racing, we now see the need and desire of many fanciers for a one loft race in Canada of world class level. We have decided that it is time to put Canada on the world map of one loft racing.

Our experience and results at young bird open races from 300 to 400 miles are second to none in the hot bed of the Canadian racing scene. It is with great pleasure and pride that I bring to Canada, a one loft race of world class.

Our loft is 105 feet long x 8 feet deep. It is based on the modern day Belgium and Dutch loft designs with a six foot high peek roof for maximum ventilation. Depending on the amount of entries we will be adding on up to 45 feet, for a total of 150 feet in length. The design of this loft works excellent in achieving super health and form.

Birds will be managed by Tony Alves and will be on a full Vita King health program. These are the same products that our racing loft has used since 2000 with great success. Birds will be fed top quality mixtures supplied by Edwards Feeds of Innisfil, Ontario. We will get all the health permits, (no quarantine required) we will pay all expenses and we will take care of the rest.

SHIP YOUNGSTERS BETWEEN APRIL 10TH TO MAY 30TH, 2010. You can deliver your birds in person or ship Air Canada or Westjet to Toronto International Airport.

SHIPPING NIGHT AUGUST 27TH, 2010. Fanciers can be present to handle their birds if they desire.

AUCTION OF RACE BIRDS: The top 20 birds will be auctioned off on Choice Pigeon with 50% of the money going to the breeder and 50% to the Hospital For Sick Children in Toronto.

We do not take any cut from the auction sale. Owners of top 20 birds will be asked to provide pedigrees.

DIRECTION TO THE LOFT: Travelling from east or west on the 401 highway to the 404 highway go north (Newmarket) to Green Lane Road. This is the last exit off the 404 highway. About 30 minutes north of the 401 highway. Go left on Green Lane Road, travelling west about two miles. On the 4th set of traffic lights you will reach Second Concession Road. Turn right going north. Continue north on the Second Concession about 4 miles (You will pass Mount Albert Road and Queensville Sideroad. Third house on the left side of the road.

FOR OUT OF TOWN GUESTS ACCOMMODATIONS: We will have plenty of parking for cars or RV's. There are motels, and hotels within 5 to 10 minutes of the Canadian International One Loft Race. If you need more information, give us a call.

All birds remain property of the owner. Prize money will be paid to the person.
